For the 2009 Camping Season

Thank you for expressing interest in Boulder Woods Campground. The camping season is from April 1st through October 31st each year. We are a family owned, midsize facility, occupying more than seventy acres of wooded and rocky terrain. We can accommodate all sizes of pop-ups, travel trailers, and RV's. There are two tenting areas and both can accommodate groups and organizations, as well as individuals and families. Both are accessible to clean bathhouses with hot shower facilities. One of our (3) bathhouses contains coin-operated washer/dryers for your convenience. We also have a trailer and RV area for use by groups and organization that is separate from the main campground for privacy, yet easily accessible to bath houses, the camp store, pools, and special events, on foot. If you are returning to the campground after hours you must purchase a gate card for \$15.00, once return you will receive your \$15.00 back if not damaged.

All of our RV sites are shaded and offer water and electrical hook-ups. We offer the choice of dumping stations or the option of having your unit pumped out on site when you pre-register in the office and pay the fee of ten (10) dollars. Dumping occurs regularly on Monday, Wednesday and Saturday. Dumping on other than these days is considered an emergency and the charge will be thirty-five (35) dollars.

For your enjoyment, equipment for basketball, horseshoes, and shuffleboard may be borrowed from the camp store for a small fee (or deposit). Teens will find the game room located, across the road, THE place to hang out! For younger campers there's a playground, miniature golf, and, perhaps, a ride on our very own fire truck. The fee of one dollar is donated for breast cancer research. In addition, there's a family pool, a toddler pool, and the very popular, ADULT pool. The pools are open from Memorial to Labor Days. Both children and adults will love riding our hay wagon every Friday night and Saturday afternoons. Hay wagons can be rented at other times for groups and organizations. There's BINGO most weekends and you can pick up an activities schedule in the store when you sign in to register. The camp Store sells a large selection of groceries and camping supplies, hand dipped ice cream (that means the biggest cones you've ever seen!) regular ice cream and frozen treats, beverages, hoagies, sandwiches, and pizza, candy, gifts, trinkets, ice, and got-to-haves, propane, bait, fishing tackle, wood, batteries, SOAP, equipment to make trailer repairs and upgrades, and attire emblazoned with the Boulder Woods logo.

Making early reservations is always recommended. You must be 21 in order to reserve a site. A one night's deposit is required to hold a site. A site fee includes one (1) camping unit, one (1) vehicle, up to two (2) adults, and their children less than 18 years of age. Additional people are \$10.00 per night. Holiday weekends additional people are \$12.00 per night. Families and individuals, groups and organizations, should consult the fee schedule which is incorporated with this letter for all current rates, service and cancellation fees. Holiday weekends must be paid for thirty days (30) in advance. Holiday cancellations are not refundable, but CREDIT will be issued - less a service fee of \$10.00 only if notified (10) ten days in advance of the reservation date. All other cancellations of reservations must be notified within seven (7) day in advance of reservation date in order to get credit less the \$10.00 service charge.

All guests must abide by the rules and regulations of Boulder Woods Campground and will receive a copy of said rules upon arrival. We want everyone's stay to be peaceful and enjoyable. We will not tolerate people who are unwilling or unable to be considerate of others.

2009 Boulder Woods Rules and Regulations

In order to preserve the pristine beauty of Boulder Woods, and to promote harmony among its campers, we ask that everyone abide by these rules.

- You must be 21 to reserve a site.
- Speed Limit is **5** mph – please drive cautiously and always watch for children.
- **QUITE TIME** is from 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Please Observe! Children under 18 must be at campsite by 11:00 p.m. and must be supervised at all times by an adult parent. Violation of quiet time you may be asked to leave with out a refund.
- Stay on Boulder Woods Campground Property.
- Camp Skymount Road is a **PUBLIC HIGHWAY..... NOT a campground road**. Please do not let your children hang out on Camp Skymount Road. Please inform your children.
- You are responsible for the registration and behavior of any **visitors** to your site. Visitors must register with the office and then leave the campground by 11:00 p.m.
- No spots lights.
- Patio Lights should be turned off when leaving the campground and when retiring for the night.
- Camp fires must remain in fire ring provided. Do not leave camp fires **unattended**.
- You are responsible **for your children**. Please do not let them wander through other's site, or leave them unattended. Vandalism and disrespect for persons or property will not be tolerated.
- Bathhouses – Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult parent. Please keep all personal items with you in bathhouses. Any personal items left in the bathhouses will be removed when they are cleaned.
- **VISITORS** are persons whom you have not registered on your site. They must stay with you in your trailer. No other camping vehicle or tent may be placed on your site for this purpose. Guests may obtain a rental site for their camper or tent (based on availability) at the store.
- **VISTORS**, you are responsible for the registration and behavior of any **visitors** at your site.
- **PETS** are the sole and full responsibility of the owners and are liable for **cleaning up after them**, keeping them leashed and well behaved within the grounds. Disturbing the neighbors by the pets is not permitted.
- Please place trash in a secure plastic bag and place by road by 2:00 p.m. on Sunday. If you are leaving before Sunday please place trash in our dumpster. (See site map for location of dumpsters)
- Televisions, radios, etc should be heard at the site you're occupying only. Loud and boisterous gatherings will not be permitted.

- Firearms – All kinds....air guns, BB guns, slingshots, paint guns and fire works are prohibited.
- The Lake is for Catch and Release Fishing Only. No Fishing License is required. **NO SWIMMING IN LAKE.** (Please see Lake Rules)
- Game Room Hours same as store. (See Game Room Rules)
- Pool is open from Memorial to Labor Day weekend. (See Pool Rules)
- Children 12 and under must wear Bike Helmets in the campground. Also all bicycles must be returned to their site after dusk. State law requires children to wear certified protective headgear.
- Boulder Woods Family Campground assumes no responsibility for the health or safety of the Seasonal Campers, their family, or their guests. All activities within the campground shall be deemed at one's own risk. These activities shall include, but are not limited to swimming, fishing, hiking, hayrides, using playground equipment, and/or participating in any other campground activity
- Wood - Camper agrees that they will not bring pallets, pressure treated or painted wood into the campground for purposes of burning. It is illegal to burn pressure treated wood for health reasons in the state of Pennsylvania. No removals of trees or branches are permitted. There is a forestry ban on moving any type of fire wood from other states currently in the state of PA due to the Emerald Ash Borer.
- Water – We are on well water, not city water. Please be considerate of your water usage. All hoses should be drip free. All vehicle washing is strictly prohibited.
- Rental Trailers – No pets or smoking allowed and must be 21 to rent. Only two adults and four children under the age of 18 can fit in the rental trailers.
- **Police** - If the police are called on behalf any camper, Boulder Woods Family Campground has the authority to require those campers to leave the campground immediately.
- Violators of the rules and regulations can be requested leave without any refund.
- \$35.00 fee for returned check.
- The Camping Season is from **April 1st to October 31st.**

Management reserves the right to make necessary changes in the rules and regulations to be in the best interest of the campground. Anyone refusing to abide by the rules and regulations or creating a disturbance will be asked to leave without refund. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone.

Lake Rules

This Lake is private property, made available for the enjoyment of Boulder Woods campers and guests only! All other public use is restricted. The following rules apply to all who use the Boulder Woods Lake facility. Failure to abide by the Lake Rules may adversely affect your stay here at Boulder Woods.

SWIMMING --- *NO SWIMMING*, Wading, Bathing, or otherwise somehow getting yourself in the Lake.

BOATING --- is *NOT* permitted.

FISHING --- is permitted. Catch and Release Only. Use barb less hooks only. A fishing License is not required. Do not remove any fish from the Lake area. Removal of fish from the Lake will result in the immediate revocation of all Lake Privileges and/or other restrictions as deemed necessary by the Boulder Woods Management.

PICNICING --- is permitted provided all trash is removed when you are finished.

CHILDREN --- children under the age of 12 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.

Our biggest problem at the Lake has been litter. We are sure you don't want to see trash in the woods or on the shore and the fish tell us they don't want to see it in the Lake either. Thank you for your cooperation

Pool hours may vary on holiday weekends
- ***POOL ATTENDANTS HAVE FULL AUTHORITY***
- *When Pool Attendant is not on duty an adult must supervise children under 16.*
- *Proper attire is required - this means bathing suits no street wear*
- *Clean water in plastic bottles only - no other beverages allowed*
- ***NO GUM ALLOWED IN POOL OR POOL AREA***
- *NO FOOD- this means no candy or chips or snacks*
- *All persons with long hair must tie it back*
- *No Pets allowed in the pool area*
- *No running in pool area*
- *No diving allowed*
- *Adult pool is for Adults 18 and older*
- *No rafts permitted in the family or kiddie pool*
- *No basketballs or other sport balls allowed in the pool*
- *Please put cigarette butts in proper container*
- ***Please put TRASH IN TRASH CANS***
- *NO horse play in the Pool area*
- *Profanity will not be tolerated. Please respect your fellow campers and their children.*
- *Parents are RESPONSIBLE for the safety and actions of their children.*
- *Any Damage done to Pool Property will be the financial responsibility of the parent or guardian.*
